### Lincoln Christian University

The name recently changed, but the mission of Lincoln Christian University remains the same. Since its founding in 1944, LCU has served more than 15,000 students and is a Christian higher education community whose goal is to nurture and equip Christians with a Biblical worldview to serve and lead in the church and the world. Today more than 1,000 students pursue their education at the main campus in Lincoln, offsite and online. LCU offers 29 degrees and certificates in the Undergraduate School, Adult and Graduate Studies and Seminary.

LCU has sent leaders into 163 of the world's 235 populated countries, including 49 of the 50 United States. Additionally, more than 14,000 people visit LCU during the course of one year.
