Training Christians for Ministry (TCM)

This month we will be featuring TCM and their work in Europe and central Asia. Originally started by Gene Dulin after visiting the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe several times during the 1960's, TCM has grown and shifted focus somewhat from helping area Christian churches to becoming a full-fledged center for Christian education. Headquartered at Haus Edelweiss near Vienna, Austria, hundreds of students are taught so they can spread the gospel to largely Muslim areas of Russia and central Asia. On June 13th you will get a chance to see what has been happening recently at TCM.

"Christmas in June" Food Drive:

Today is the last day for the food drive for South Side Mission. There are two 55-gallon barrels and a linen cart in the foyer. If you could please bring **at least ONE or more non-perishable food item or article of clothing** to donate, South Side Mission would really appreciate it! The following is a list of items that the food pantry always needs: boxed or bagged cereals (10/12 oz), boxes of instant or scalloped potatoes, boxed macaroni & cheese, cake mix, canned fruits /vegetables, canned tuna, chicken or salmon, grain crackers, grits (instant), hamburger/ tuna helper, jelly, oatmeal (instant), pasta/macaroni, peanut butter, soups, and spaghetti sauce.

Threads of Love Clothing Center:

Our church has an opportunity to help clothe those in need. Several churches in Washington are working together to form a clothing closet. They will take donations of clothes and distribute them for free on specific days to those who are in need. They will also have clothing and hygiene items for emergencies, for those who may have had a fire or other type of emergency, or in a domestic abuse situation.

This unique collaboration of the community in Washington is now called "**Threads of Love Clothing Center**". They have not yet acquired a store front, and in order to help the community over the summer, will be holding clothing drives each month in various churches. The first one will be held on Sat, June 26th, from 9:00-12:00 noon at Sunnyland Christian Church.

There are several ways WCC can help. First, in order to raise funds for the center, they are having a community day on June 14th at Monical's. Please find Kim Taylor and ask her for a flyer, and then if you eat at Monical's that day, a percentage of all food sold will benefit Threads of Love.

Second, we will need many hands/feet for the clothing giveaway. Besides an opportunity to help the Washington community, we will also have the privilege of working side by side with other Christians in our community. We need volunteers to help take clothes to Sunnyland on the 25th, as well as volunteers to help sort clothes and work at Sunnyland Christian the day of the giveaway, both in set up, during the giveaway, and help tearing down. This is the first time attempting such a multi-church giveaway, and many hands will make light work. Please let Kim Taylor know if you are able to help. More specific times for the June 25th sorting will follow later.

And finally, they will need clothing. They would like to receive about 15 bins or boxes of clothing from each church. Please let Kim know if you have some to donate. They would like to have summer or light-weight clothing for this first giveaway, and we need to try and sort it by men's, women's, boys, girls, infants, shoes, with sizes if possible. (ie. women's-Large).

For the emergency part of this endeavor, items for this will be temporarily located at Crossroads UMC. We will send a letter to local police and fire departments, shelters, etc so we can help those in emergency situations. We are in need of some

items for the center such as underwear of all sizes, bras, full size toothpastes, shampoos & conditioners, hair brushes and combs, deodorant & feminine products. Please contact Kim if you can donate any of these items.
